



Unknown Suspect Sought for Logan Heights Sexual Battery; Suspect Composite Released

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and Investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Central Division are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a suspect wanted for sexual battery.

On July 19, 2010 at about 6:40 A.M., a 15 year old female victim was walking west on 2700 Commercial on the north curb. As she crossed Hensley Street she noticed the described suspect walking south on Hensley in her direction. The victim continued west on Commercial when the suspect came from behind, put his hand up her skirt and touched her buttocks. The suspect was last seen on foot headed towards Hensley Street.

Suspect Description: Hispanic male, 28-32 years old, dark skin, 5'5"-5'-7", 200-220 lbs (stocky to chubby build), short black hair (#4 clip buzzed cut), round face, brown eyes, and wore a white t-shirt and dark blue jeans..
