WHO/WHAT: The San Diego Police Foundation (SDPF) announces **funding of a \$126,000 evidence management system for the San Diego Police Department (SDPD)**. Made possible by the generosity of individual and corporate donors, the new system will digitize the Property Room, boosting the efficiency and effectiveness of a key function of law enforcement.

WHY IT'S IMPORTANT: The tracking system by which evidence is currently received, monitored and used within the department is a paper system. By bringing this one system into the digital age, thousands of officer hours will be freed up annually to assist with the SDPD's first priority: responding to emergencies.

The new evidence management system encompasses the software, hardware, training and maintenance necessary to provide an efficient solution. This program is the top funding priority the SDPD has asked the Foundation to fund at year-end in order to empower SDPD's efforts in 2011.
