### **POLICE ARREST TWO SUSPECTS IN 2007 MURDER CASE**

On November 18, 2007, David Coronado was shot and killed in the backyard of a residence in the 6100 block of Brooklyn Avenue. Detectives quickly learned the suspects had fled to Mexico. The case was presented to the San Diego County District Attorney's Office and arrest warrants were issued for Jaime Lizarraga 20 and his brother Ramiro Lizarraga 24. At that time wanted bulletins were distributed to Mexican authorities.

On May 27, 2011, at approximately 1700 hours, both brothers were taken into custody by the Preventive State Police in Colonia La Mesa, Tijuana BC Mexico. The Lizarragas are United States citizens and were formally deported back to the United States by the Mexican government. They were turned over to US Customs and Immigration who handed them over to San Diego Police Officers. They were booked into county jail for the murder of Mr. Coronado.
