## **MEMORIAL DAY HOLIDAY DUI SATURATION PATROLS NET 33 ARRESTS**

On Friday May 27, 2011, the San Diego Police Department and the San Diego County Probation Department conducted a joint operation targeting DUI offenders who are currently on felony probation for DUI. Officers attempted to observe the “Worst of the Worst” DUI offenders utilizing stakeout operations. All probationers contacted were found to be in compliance.

At the conclusion of the “Worst of the Worst” operation, SDPD and Probation Department officers teamed up and conducted DUI saturation patrols in the Pacific Beach area. Eighteen drivers were arrested for DUI and 7 vehicles were impounded.

On Sunday May 29, 2011, the San Diego Police Department conducted a DUI saturation patrol in the Pacific Beach area. Fifteen drivers were arrested for DUI, eleven hazardous citations were issued, and 4 vehicles were impounded.

The operations were funded by the DUI Awareness and Enforcement grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. To report Drunk Drivers – Call 9-1-1!
