



## Detectives Looking for Leads to Help Identify and Locate Three Unknown Suspects Wanted for a Pedestrian Robbery

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Central Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate three unknown suspects wanted for a pedestrian robbery.

*Detectives said on April 19, 2011, at approximately 11:00 a.m., a 17-year-old victim was walking on the sidewalk at 1000 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue in downtown San Diego. The victim was approached by three unknown black males who asked if they could borrow his cell phone. The victim reluctantly handed over his cell phone and all three suspects threatened to assault the victim if he tried to get his phone back. The victim, fearing he would be assaulted, walked away from the three suspects. The suspects were last seen walking northbound on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue towards C Street. The victim immediately called the police from a payphone. A nearby surveillance camera captured a picture of all three suspects.*

*All three suspects are Black males, approximately 18-20 years-old (Pictures of the suspects are attached to page two of this release)*

Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest in this case.
