On Friday, June 17, 2011, San Diego Police Department Northeastern Division officers will conduct a juvenile curfew sweep. The goal of the sweep is to protect and educate juveniles, as well as reduce crime by creating a positive police presence in communities.

By enforcing curfew laws, this sweep will attempt to address the issue of juvenile crimes, both preventing them from committing crimes or becoming the victims of crimes.
