ARRESTS MADE IN LOCAL TOY DRIVE BURGLARY

(San Diego, CA) San Diego Police Department detectives from Eastern Division have arrested Timoteo and Rowena Orque in connection with a commercial burglary of toys donated to the Ronald Mc Donald House Charities during this past Christmas season.

On December 16, 2010, the suspects, a man and a woman, entered the North Island Credit Union located at 5898 Copley Drive in San Diego at about 11:00 a.m. Employees at the Credit Union had set up a toy donation bin for the Ronald Mc Donald House Charities and placed it in the lobby. The suspects entered with an empty mail bin and walked directly to the donation bin containing brand new toys. The suspects took several toys and placed them in the mail bin, covering them with a jacket. The suspects then exited the building and fled in a burgundy vehicle. The incident was caught on surveillance video.

After a lengthy investigation, detectives determined the registered owner of the burgundy vehicle was Timoteo Orque. Orque and his wife, Rowena Orque matched both suspects seen on the surveillance video.

On April 4, 2011, detectives arrested Timoteo and Rowena Orque at their residence. They were arrested on one count each of commercial burglary.
