On October 12, 2010, 19-year-old Diana Gonzalez was murdered on the campus of San Diego City College. Her estranged husband, Armando Perez, fled to Mexico after the murder, and the vehicle he used to get there has been recovered.

A warrant charging Perez with murder has been issued by San Diego Superior Court. A Provisional Arrest Warrant has also been issued by the Mexican government, permitting Perez' arrest by Mexican law enforcement before an extradition hearing to determine if Perez will be returned to the United States for prosecution.

San Diego Police Department detectives have worked closely with Mexican law enforcement, but Perez continues to be a fugitive, and he is believed to be living in Tijuana.

The San Diego Police Department requests the assistance of Mexican citizens to locate and arrest Armando Perez for the murder of his wife. San Diego County Crime Stoppers is offering a reward of up to \$1,000 for information leading to Perez' arrest.
