ARREST MADE IN TODAY'S CHASE BANK ROBBERY

(San Diego, CA) San Diego Police Department Central Division patrol officers have arrested Anthony Munoz, 57, for a bank robbery that occurred earlier today.

This morning at about 10:15 a.m., a male suspect entered the Chase Bank located at 101 W. Broadway near Horton Plaza. The suspect approached a teller and made a verbal demand for cash. The teller initially did not believe she was actually being robbed, so the suspect added that he was armed with a gun and repeated his demand for cash. The teller gave him an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspect walked out of the bank, eastbound on Broadway.

The suspect was described as a Hispanic male in his 50's with white hair and a white mustache. The suspect was wearing a beige baseball cap and a gray jacket.

Only moments later, a San Diego Police Officer responding to the bank saw Munoz at the northeast corner of 1st Avenue and Broadway, waiting for the bus. Munoz was arrested and the stolen cash was recovered.

Anthony Richard Munoz (02-08-55) will be booked into San Diego County Jail on one count of commercial robbery. He is expected to be arraigned on Thursday, February 16, 2012 in San Diego Superior Court.
