### **SUSPECT SOUGHT IN RECENT PHARMACY ROBBERY**

**(San Diego)** San Diego Police Department Robbery Unit detectives are looking for the suspect responsible for a recent pharmacy robbery in the La Jolla area.

On March 29, 2012, at about 8:15 p.m., a male wearing sunglasses and a "Chargers" beanie cap entered the CVS Pharmacy, located at 5495 La Jolla Boulevard. The male walked directly to the back of the store and entered the restricted area behind the pharmacy counter. He pointed a handgun at the pharmacist and demanded Oxycontin, Xanax and Vicodin. The pharmacist put several bottles of the drugs in a plastic "CVS Pharmacy" bag. The suspect walked out of the store in an unknown direction.

The suspect is described as a black male, in his late 30's to 50's, 6' tall with a thin to medium build. He wore a dark hoodie, dark jeans, San Diego Chargers beanie cap, black sunglasses and black gloves.

The robbery was captured on surveillance video. Copies of the video are available at the San Diego Police Department Headquarters Broadway customer service counter.
