SDPD RELEASES STATISTICS FROM THE MEMORIAL DAY HOLIDAY WEEKEND

(San Diego) City officials estimate approximately 460,400 people visited the beach and bay areas over the three day Memorial Day holiday weekend, which began Saturday, May 26, 2012 and continued through Monday, May 28, 2012. Despite the large crowds at the beaches, bays, parks, and entertainment districts, there were no significant incidents and the weekend proved to be a safe and enjoyable one for visitors and residents alike. This is attributable to the successful on-going relationships between citizen groups and City departments, as well as cooperative efforts and pre-planning between Police, Fire, Lifeguards, and Park and Recreation employees.
