SDPD RELEASES STATISTICS FROM THE LABOR DAY HOLIDAY WEEKEND

(San Diego) City officials estimate approximately 661,200 people visited the beach and bay areas over the four day Labor Day holiday weekend, which began Friday, August 31, 2012 at 2:00 p.m. and continued through midnight on Monday, September 3, 2012. Despite the large crowds at the beaches, bays, parks, and entertainment districts, there were no significant incidents and the weekend proved to be a safe and enjoyable one for visitors and residents alike. This is attributable to the successful on-going relationships between citizen groups and City departments, as well as cooperative efforts and pre-planning between Police, Fire, Lifeguards, and Park and Recreation employees.
