### **SUSPECTS SOUGHT IN REDWOOD VILLAGE 7-11 ROBBERY**

**(San Diego)** San Diego Police Department Robbery Unit detectives are looking for the suspects responsible for a recent robbery at a Redwood Village/ Rolando Park convenience store.

On November 23, 2012, just before 3:00 a.m., two males entered the 7-11 store located at 3600 College Avenue and approached the clerk at the customer service counter. One suspect pointed a handgun at the clerk and demanded cash from the register while the second suspect sat on the counter and removed the cash from the drawer. The suspects demanded more money, but the clerk said he could not access any more. The suspects then demanded cigarettes. The clerk handed them a few packs of cigarettes and the suspects ran out of the store.

The suspects are described as two black male 25 to 30 years of age. The armed suspect is between 5'10" and 6' tall with a medium build. He wore a black hooded jacket with the hood pulled up and light-colored cargo shorts. He had a gray bandana covering the lower portion of his face. The suspect who took the money is between 5'6" and 5'8" with a heavy build. He wore a black hooded sweatshirt with the hood up over a black beanie cap and light-colored sweatpants. The weapon used was a black semi-automatic pistol.

The robbery was captured on surveillance video. Copies of the video are available at the San Diego Police Department Headquarters Broadway customer service counter.
