



Surveillance Camera Captures Clear Pictures of ATM Burglary Suspect

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Northwestern Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate a suspect wanted in connection with an attempt ATM burglary at Bank of America in San Diego.

Detectives said on February 6, 2013, approximately 20 minutes after midnight, an unknown suspect attempted to burglarize the stand alone Bank of America ATM located at 13350 Camino Del Sur in San Diego. The suspect was unable to open the ATM and left the scene without gaining access. The suspect caused approximately \$20,000 dollars in damage to the ATM.

Suspect Description: Asian male, 20-30 years old, clean shaven, wearing a gray zip up hooded sweatshirt, white t-shirt and white baseball cap. The cap is white with red and blue 2009 Poinsettia Bowl logo on the front "Cal" on left side and "U" in circle with two feathers on right side.

A surveillance camera captured very clear pictures of the suspect. The pictures are attached to this email and page 2 of the release.
