



Unknown Suspect Wanted for Commercial Burglary; Suspect Images Captured by Surveillance Camera

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Central Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate an unknown suspect wanted for commercial burglary.

Detectives said on August 28, 2013, at approximately 3:00 a.m., an unknown suspect used a pry tool to break the glass front doors to Unite Salon, located at 1452 7th Avenue in San Diego. Once inside the business, the suspect grabbed a cash box, which contained an undisclosed amount of money, located at the reception front desk. The suspect was last scene on foot leaving the business with the cash box. The suspect may have sustained an injury to his head. As he was leaving the business, he attempted to run through the unbroken side of the glass doors, hitting his head and bouncing backwards before leaving through the broken door. Suspect Description: Hispanic male, medium height and build. He had a shaved head and mustache. He was wearing a light colored shirt, dark jacket, light shorts, tennis shoes, and was wearing a backpack.
