DETECTIVES INVESTIGATE A RESIDENTIAL HOT PROWL BURGLARY


(San Diego) San Diego Police Department detectives from the Sex Crimes Unit are investigating a residential burglary that occurred early Wednesday morning in the area of 10100 Black Mountain Road in San Diego.

On March 12, 2014, at approximately 00:37 a.m. an unknown male entered the residence through an upstairs balcony. The male entered while the female resident and her children were sleeping. The victim awoke and saw the suspect standing in her bedroom. The victim confronted the suspect, who fled out the balcony door in an unknown direction.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic or Asian male with short, light brown hair, in his early to mid twenties (20's). He is between 5'6" and 5'8" tall with a medium build. He was wearing a necklace, a white t-shirt tank top, and unknown colored pants or shorts. A witness indicated the male was not wearing shoes at the time.
