MISSING PERSON

JENNIPHER SMITH



San Diego Police Department detectives continue to look for leads to help locate missing person Jennipher **SMITH**. Miss **SMITH** was last seen on April 29, 2014 at approximately 3:54 p.m. after conducting a transaction at the Bank of America branch located at 655 West Broadway in the Core-Columbia community of San Diego, California. Miss **SMITH's** cellular telephone was subsequently found on May 6, 2014 at approximately 2:00 p.m. in the area of Highway 94 at the 32nd Street on-ramp in Stockton community of San Diego, California. Miss **SMITH** is suffering from a deteriorating mental health condition and has medical conditions, which can cause involuntary incapacitation. Miss **SMITH** arrived from Boise, Idaho at the Los Angeles International Airport on April 27, 2014 enroute to the University of California at Los Angeles Medical Center for treatment. Miss **SMITH** never arrived at that facility.
