



Unknown Suspect Wanted for Commercial Burglaries Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Western Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate the suspect wanted in a series of commercial burglaries targeting the Five and Dime General Store.

On March 1, 2014, at about 8:00 p.m., an unknown adult male suspect walked into the Five & Dime General Store located at 2501 San Diego Avenue. The suspect was seen on surveillance cameras cutting wires to the business's security alarm system. A few hours later, the suspect returned to the business and kicked in the rear door. The suspect left after forcing the door open, but returned about thirty minutes later and completed the burglary.

On April 25, 2014, at about 9:40 p.m., the same suspect returned to the business and is captured on surveillance cameras cutting the business's security alarm system. The suspect did not return to the business to complete the burglary.

Surveillance cameras captured pictures of the suspect. The pictures are attached to this email and page 2 of this release.
