



Unknown Suspect Wanted for Kidnapping/Robbery Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate the suspect wanted for armed kidnapping and robbery.

On May 4, 2014, at about 12:40 a.m., an unknown male suspect approached two women as they were getting into their car in the 7700 block of Draper Avenue. The suspect was armed with a semi-automatic handgun and forced both women into their own car. The suspect also got into the car and sat behind the driver. He forced the female driver to drive to two nearby ATM's where he ordered both of them to withdraw money from their accounts. The suspect told the driver to take him back to Draper Avenue where he got out of the car and fled on foot. The suspect told the victim that he lived in the area.

The suspect is described as a Black male, 24 to 28 years-old, about 6'1" to 6'2" tall, muscular build, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and dark baggy fitting jeans.

A composite sketch was created of the suspect. The sketch is attached to this email and page 2 of this release.
