



## Unknown Suspects Wanted for Annoying/Molesting Children

**Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered**

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Eastern Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate unknown suspects wanted for annoying/molesting children.

*On March 3, 2014, at approximately 4:15 p.m., in the area Lake Atlin Avenue and Lake Ashmere Drive, an unknown White male, driving an older small silver 4-door sedan, approached two girls, ages 12 and 13-years-old. The suspect asked the girls inappropriate questions and continued questioning the girls as they walked away. The suspect drove away when one of the girls pulled out her cell phone. The suspect in this incident is described as a White male, 25 to 35 years old, short slicked back black hair and goatee. The suspect was wearing a light colored t-shirt, rectangular reading glasses and had an earring in his left ear.*

*On May 21, 2014, at approximately 5:20 p.m., in the area of Blue Lake Drive and Twin Lake Drive, an unknown White male driving an older small gray 4-door sedan, approached two girls, ages 11 and 13-years-old. The suspect told the victims to get into his vehicle while asking inappropriate questions. The victims ran and the suspect drove away. The suspect in this case is described as a White male, 25-35 years old, short straight brown hair, normal build, and was wearing thick framed glasses. The suspect was wearing a button-up white and blue pinstriped shirt with a black tie.*

*Detectives believe both cases may be related.*
