



Unknown Suspect Wanted for Armed Robbery Surveillance Pictures of Suspect Attached to Release Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate an unknown suspect wanted in connection with two armed commercial robberies targeting Walmart.

On 05/06/2014, at about 10:00 p.m., an unknown suspect entered the Walmart located at 3412 College Avenue in San Diego. The suspect approached a cashier, produced a black handgun, and made a demand for cash. The cashier apparently did not open the cash drawer fast enough and the suspect fired his handgun into the ceiling. The suspect then removed the cash from the drawer and fled the scene in an unknown make or model vehicle, which had a white driver's side door and front quarter panel.

The suspect is described as a Black male, 30 to 40 years of age, 5'8" to 6'1" tall, heavy build, wearing a gray cap, a black and gray sweater/jacket, a red and black flannel shirt under the jacket, black pants, and white tennis shoes. The suspect had a beard and his hair was pulled back into a bun.

It is believed that the same suspect robbed the same Walmart on November 23, 2013. In that case, the suspect also fired his handgun towards the ceiling.

Surveillance cameras captured pictures of the suspect. The pictures are attached to this email and pages 2 and 3 of the release.

Anyone with information on the identity or location of the suspect is asked to call the SDPD Robbery Unit at (619) 531-2299 or the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
