POLICE IDENTIFY OFFICERS INVOLVED IN SHOOTING WITH HOMICIDE SUSPECT IN CITY HEIGHTS

On Saturday, April 18, 2015, at 00:49 a.m., the San Diego Police Department received a 911 call of a prowler armed with a handgun attempting to break into several apartments in the complex located at 3810 Winona Avenue. Police believed the suspect in this call was related to an armed robbery and homicide that occurred on April 16, 2015. Several officers responded and began a search of the entire complex while gathering additional information on the suspect's location.

At 2:49 a.m., two San Diego Police Detectives were going to check for the suspect in the complex community room. As the detectives approached the door, the suspect began shooting through the door, narrowly missing both officers. Both officers returned fire and struck the suspect at least one time in the torso. The suspect was taken into custody and transported to Mercy Hospital for treatment of non-life threatening injuries.

The suspect has been identified as 30 year-old Ahmed Hassan Mumin of San Diego.

The two officers involved in the shooting are James Mackay, a 25 year veteran and Luke Johnson, a 12 year veteran.
