



Unknown Suspects Wanted for Murder

\$1,000 REWARD

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit are asking for the public's assistance in solving the murder of Clarence Edward Carllel III.

On June 8, 2015, at approximately 10:45 p.m., the San Diego Police Department received a call of a shooting that occurred near the intersection of 47th Street and Logan Avenue in the Lincoln Park Community.

When officers arrived, they located 24-year-old Clarence Edward Carllel III lying in the middle of the Logan Avenue just east of 47th Street. Carllel had sustained multiple gunshot wounds to his torso. Police and medics attempted life saving measures, but Carllel succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Citizens reported that Carllel was walking with another young male in his early 20's across 4700 Logan Avenue. A red 4-door vehicle, possibly a Nissan or a Honda, reportedly stopped in an eastbound traffic lane and yelled something to the males crossing the street. Several shots were fired from the vehicle toward the males, striking Carllel several times in his torso area. Carllel's companion was not injured during the shooting. Two unknown males were believed to be in the suspect vehicle, which fled eastbound on Logan Avenue.

Crime Stoppers is offering a \$1,000 reward for information that leads to an arrest in this murder.
