



Unknown Suspect Wanted for Felony Vandalism Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

August 5, 2015

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Northeastern Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate a suspect wanted for breaking the front glass door of the Northeastern Division's Mira Mesa Storefront along with the windshields of two Retired Senior Volunteer Patrol vehicles.

On June 7, 2015, at approximately 9:17 p.m., an unknown male walked to the front of the Northeastern Division's Mira Mesa Storefront located at 8450 Mira Mesa Boulevard, in San Diego. The male threw a brick through the front glass door of the storefront shattering the door. The male then walked to the side of the storefront and threw rocks at the front windshields of two separate Retired Senior Volunteer Patrol (RSVP's) marked vehicles. The rocks caused both windshields to shatter. The total damage to the windshields and door is estimated at \$1,100.

Suspect Description: The suspect is described as a Black male, wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt (with no logo or design on it), light colored pants, and dark colored shoes. The male may have a light beard.
