Traffic Division Investigators locate hit and run vehicle with public's assistance

San Diego, CA – On September 17th at 7:50 a.m., a female bicyclist was struck by a vehicle and severely injured on 2700 Clairemont Drive, west of Galveston Street. The woman was riding eastbound in the bike lane and was struck by a vehicle traveling in the same direction. The driver of the vehicle did not stop.

Witnesses described the vehicle as being a dark blue, small compact or sub compact car and should have front bumper and hood damage. The passenger side rear view mirror was left at the scene.

Based on information provided by a citizen, the above vehicle has been located. The San Diego Police Department would like to express our appreciation to the public for their assistance during this investigation.
