Suspect Wanted in Felony Hit and Run

Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

October 12, 2015

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate a suspect wanted in a felony hit and run.

On October 9th, 2015, at approximately 8:20 p.m., several vehicles were traveling north on the 3600 block of 54th Street in San Diego, when one of those vehicle suddenly swerved to avoid hitting a 15-year-old teenager lying on the road. A Dodge Caravan that was immediately behind the first car had no time to react and struck the teenager. The driver drove away from the scene and the teenager died as a result of being struck by the vehicle.

Witnesses had seen the 15-year-old teenager skateboarding in the street prior ot being struck. It is not clear if the teenager had been hit by another car before being struck by the Dodge Caravan.

The suspect vehicle is described as a green Dodge Caravan with California license plate 4DQJ456. The Caravan has been sold and the DMV registration is not up to date.
