### **POLICE IDENTIFY VICTIMS IN MOUNTAIN VIEW DOUBLE HOMICIDE**

**On Sunday, November 8, 2015, at 7:59 p.m., the San Diego Police Department received several 911 calls of gunshots and two people shot in the 4300 block of Newton Avenue.**

**When officers arrived, they located a male and female, both in their 20's, lying in the driveway behind a residence in the 1100 block of South 43<sup>rd</sup> Street. Both victims' had sustained gunshot wounds to the upper body. Responding officers and paramedics attempted life-saving measures, but both victims were pronounced deceased at the scene.**

**The preliminary investigation revealed there was an argument between the two victims and a Hispanic male acquaintance before the male shot the two victims.**

**The two victims have been identified as 20 year old Arline Iribe and 22 year old Alexis Velarde, both of San Diego. The two victims are brother and sister.**

**The suspect has been identified as 39 year old Felipe Vega of San Diego. Vega is currently a fugitive and is considered armed and dangerous.**
