### **POLICE INVESTIGATE DOUBLE HOMICIDE IN MOUNTAIN VIEW COMMUNITY**

**On Sunday, November 8, 2015, at 7:59 p.m., the San Diego Police Department received several 911 calls of gunshots and two people shot in the 4300 block of Newton Avenue.**

**When officers arrived, they located a male and female, both in their 20's, lying in the driveway behind a residence in the 1100 block of South 43<sup>rd</sup> Street. Both victims' had sustained gunshot wounds to the upper body. Responding officers and paramedics attempted life-saving measures, but both victims were pronounced deceased at the scene.**

**The preliminary investigation revealed there was an argument between the two victims and a Hispanic male acquaintance before the male shot the two victims. The male then fled the scene and is currently a fugitive.**

**The suspect has been identified as 39 year old Felipe Vega of San Diego and he is considered armed and dangerous.**

**The victims' identities are known, but will not be released pending further family notifications.**
