Arrests of Armed Kidnapping and Robbery Suspects

San Diego, CA –

On November 23, 2015, at approximately 5:00 p.m., an adult male approached an adult female who was pushing a shopping cart in the parking lot of the Worlds Food Supermarket located at 5245 El Cajon Boulevard. The male grabbed the female's purse from her shoulder and threw her to the ground. The male got into a black SUV and fled the area.

On November 27, 2015, at approximately 6:15 p.m., an adult female was walking to her vehicle in the 4200 block of Chamoune Avenue. An adult male approached the female and pointed a silver handgun at her and took her purse. The male fled the area on foot.

On November 27, 2015, at approximately 9:15 p.m., an adult female walked out of the CVS Pharmacy located at 4404 El Cajon Boulevard and got into her vehicle. An adult male knocked on the window and displayed a silver handgun. The male got into her vehicle and ordered her to drive to two different banks and had the victim withdraw cash from the bank ATMs. The male then ordered her to drive him to a liquor store in the 5500 block of University Avenue where the male told the female to purchase several bottles of alcohol. The male told the female to drive him to the 4300 block of Highland Avenue where he got out of the vehicle and fled the area on foot.

On November 30, 2015, at approximately 6:25 p.m., an adult female was walking to her vehicle, which was in the CVS Pharmacy parking lot located at 7100 Broadway, in Lemon Grove. Two adult males grabbed the female and physically forced her into their vehicle. The males drove the female to multiple bank ATM locations, where the female was forced to withdraw cash. The female was later dropped off near the intersection of 54th Street and El Cajon Boulevard.

Evidence recovered from each case led investigators from both the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit and the San Diego County Sheriff's Department Rancho San Diego Station to believe these cases were related. Both agencies worked together during the investigation to determine and locate the suspects responsible for these crimes.

On December 2, 2015, Kha Sok (33) was arrested by the San Diego Police Robbery Unit detectives for two counts of kidnapping for robbery, two counts of armed robbery, and two counts of robbery.

Later in the evening, San Diego Sheriff's Rancho San Diego Station detectives arrested David Tonn (28) for one count of kidnapping for robbery, one count of kidnapping, and one count of robbery.

Both suspects were booked into County jail.
