



Unknown Suspect Wanted for Pharmacy Robbery Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate an unknown suspect wanted for robbery.

On January 13, 2015, at about 2:00 p.m., a male walked into the CVS Pharmacy located at 7525 Eads Avenue, in San Diego. The male approached the pharmacy counter and gave the employee a demand note. The note stated the male had a gun and wanted Roxicodone, which is a generic name for oxycodone. The employee complied and gave the male pills. The male left the store in an unknown direction.

Suspect Description: White male, 25 to 35-years-old, 6'2" tall, thin build, and has a scruffy beard. He was wearing a blue zip-up hooded sweatshirt with a white design on it, white t-shirt, brown beanie style hat, blue jeans, brown work boots, and large sunglasses with yellow lenses.

Surveillance video captured pictures of the suspect. The pictures are attached to page 2 of this release.
