



Unknown Suspect(s) Wanted for Possession of Explosive Device and Vandalism

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

February 25, 2015

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Northeastern Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate an unknown suspect(s) who vandalized seventeen different vehicles in the Scripps Ranch area.

Between the dates of February 12, 2015 and February 15, 2015, there were seventeen different vehicles vandalized that were parked on Elderwood Lane in the Scripps Ranch area. Most of the incidents took place late at night or early in the morning and ranged from scratches to broken mirrors and windows. There were also two separate Molotov cocktails thrown towards vehicles.

The suspect vehicle is described as a late model, dark colored, Nissan Xterra with a roof rack.

A surveillance picture of the suspect vehicle is attached to page 2 of this release.

Anyone with information on the identity or location of the suspect(s) or suspect vehicle is asked to call the SDPD's Northeastern Division at (858) 538-8000 or the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
