



Unknown Suspect Wanted for Second Pharmacy Robbery Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate an unknown suspect wanted for a second pharmacy robbery.

On January 21, 2015, at about 11:45 a.m., a male walked into the Walgreens Pharmacy located at 8766 Navajo Road, in San Diego. The male approached the pharmacy counter and gave the employee a demand note. The note stated the male had a gun and wanted oxycodone. The employee complied and gave the male pills. The male left the store in an unknown direction.

Investigators believe the same male robbed the CVS Pharmacy located at 7525 Eads Avenue, in San Diego on January 13, 2015.

Suspect Description: White male, 25 to 35-years-old, 5'11" tall, thin build, and is unshaven. He was wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans, brown work boots, dark sunglasses, and a gray and black colored baseball cap with "Oakland" on the front.

Surveillance video captured pictures of the suspect. The pictures from both robberies are attached to pages 2 and 3 of this release.
