MURDER VICTIM



JACKSON JONES

San Diego Police Department detectives continue to look for leads to help solve the murder of Jackson Jones. Mr. Jones, a Yellow Cab taxi driver, was dispatched for a fare in the 4500 block of 60th Street in the El Cerrito community of San Diego, California on **April 27, 1992** at approximately 12:15 a.m. Approximately 30 minutes later, a citizen notified police of a driver of a taxi cab slumped over the steering wheel of his cab in the 4100 block of Colts Way, which is approximately .8 miles from the location where Mr. Jones was dispatched. Officers responded to this location and found Mr. Jones deceased having been shot in the head. It is believed Mr. Jones was shot during a robbery.
