



MISSION BAY PARK VISITOR TIPS

Have a Safe and Responsible Summer



The following visitor tips will help ensure that you, your family and friends have a safe and enjoyable visit. Be courteous and respectful of others. Please slow down and drive carefully.

The following laws are strictly enforced:

- *Alcoholic Beverages are PROHIBITED from 8:00 P.M. to noon. Please obey posted signs. There is no alcohol allowed on the Boardwalk or public streets at any time. 25620(a) B&P*
- *Glass bottles or glass containers are NOT allowed at any time in the beach or park areas. 63.0102(b)(12)SDMC*
- *Camping is NOT permitted on the beach or parks. 63.0102(b)(12)SDMC*
- *Household furniture is NOT permitted on the beach. 63.20.5(h)SDMC*
- *The use of barriers is NOT permitted on the beach. This includes ropes, cords, barrier tapes, tents and other similar devices. 63.20.5(i)SDMC*
- *Kegs are NOT permitted on July 4th 56.71(a)SDMC*
- *Fire Ring use is permitted 5:00 A.M. to Midnight. No pallets are allowed, only clean wood can be used. Pallets leave nails that are bad for the environment and dangerous in the sand. 63.20.5(g)SDMC*
- *No loud music, stereo or noise. Noise laws are strictly enforced. Your audio equipment may be impounded. 59.5.0502(f)SDMC*
- *Parking lots are closed when full. Please ask for directions to another park or beach area that may not be as crowded.*
- *Cruising is prohibited.*
