Most City Facilities to Close July 4 for Independence Day, Trash and Recyclables to be Collected One Day Later

SAN DIEGO - All City of San Diego offices and most City facilities will be closed Tuesday, July 4, in observance of Independence Day.

Refuse and recyclables normally picked up the week of Independence Day will be collected one day later due to observance of the holiday. Collection will return to the normal schedule beginning Monday, July 10. The Miramar Landfill will be open on the holiday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Metered parking and "No Parking" street-sweeping signs will not be enforced July 4. All other parking restrictions, including those in the vicinity of PETCO Park, will be in effect and enforced on that day.

The Central Library and all branch libraries will be closed. Book drops will remain open at all library locations. All Community Service Center and Police Storefronts and recreation centers will also be closed, however, city swimming pools will be open.

Balboa Park, Mission Bay and Torrey Pines Golf Complexes will be open, and holiday rates will apply. For information on the operating hours of the City's lakes call 619-465-3474.
