Most City Facilities to Close September 5 for Labor Day Trash and Recyclables to be Collected One Day Later

SAN DIEGO - All City of San Diego offices and most City facilities will be closed Monday, September 5, in observance of Labor Day.

Refuse and recyclables normally picked up the week of September 5 will be collected one day later due to observance of the holiday. Collection will return to the normal schedule beginning Monday, September 12. The Miramar Landfill will be open on the holiday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Metered parking and "No Parking" street-sweeping signs will not be enforced September 5. All other parking restrictions, including those in the vicinity of PETCO Park, will be in effect and enforced on that day. The Police Department recommends arriving early if you plan to go to any of the City's beaches over the Labor Day weekend. Parking lots are filled and available street parking is usually taken by 10 a.m. to 11 a.m. each day.

The Central Library and all branch libraries will be closed. Book drops will remain open at all library locations. All Community Service Centers will also be closed.

Balboa Park, Mission Bay and Torrey Pines Golf Complexes will be open. Most recreation centers will be closed. All pools will be open on limited schedules.
