MAYOR REMINDS SAN DIEGANS TO OBSERVE NEW WATER RULES

Mayor Jerry Sanders reminds San Diegans that the city's fall and winter water regulations kick in starting today. Under the city's mandatory water-savings rules, residents can water their lawns only seven minutes per watering station from Nov. 1 to May 31, with certain exceptions for owners of water-efficient sprinkler systems. As of today, residents can water their lawns before 10 a.m. and after 4 p.m..

The number of days that residents can water their lawns remains the same year-round – three. Homes with odd-numbered addresses can water Sundays, Tuesdays and Thursdays. Homes with even-numbered addresses can water Saturdays, Mondays and Wednesdays. Apartments, condos and businesses can water Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
