MAYOR BOB FILNER APPLAUDS VOLUNTEERS FOR RANCHO BERNARDO COMMUNITY PARK IMPROVEMENTS

(San Diego) -- Mayor Bob Filner paid a visit to the Rancho Bernardo Community Park “Snack Shack” after hearing that someone was willing to make necessary repairs to the concession stand’s damaged roof at no cost to the City.

“It is heartwarming and inspiring to see the people of this community take the initiative in improving their neighborhoods. When I heard there was a volunteer who was willing to fix the roof for free, it made perfect sense to make sure this project moves forward as soon as possible,” said Mayor Filner.

San Diego Councilmember Mark Kersey welcomed the Mayor to his district and both of them personally thanked Brian Duggan, owner of Roof King Roofing, Inc. for donating the time and materials to make the repairs. Other contributors include Protech Painting, Eagle Tile, Sharkskin Roof Underlayment and Fast Signs Escondido. Nick Anastasopoulos, President of the Rancho Bernardo Recreation Council spearheaded the effort.

“It’s so important for the community to come together and this is a perfect example of how we can all make a difference pitching in and making our neighborhoods better. We appreciate the Mayor coming out and taking an interest in our park,” said Councilmember Mark Kersey.

Construction on the roof officially starts on Monday. The project is expected to be completed by Saturday. The estimated cost of the roof repairs being donated by Roof King Roofing, Inc., is around \$15,000.
