HOLIDAY SCHEDULE FOR CITY OFFICES AND SERVICES

FRIDAY, JANUARY 1, 2010 NEW YEAR'S DAY

EMERGENCIES:

- Police and Fire emergency crews will be on duty.
- Patrol Officers will be on duty.
- Station 38 (citywide emergency dispatch center) will be on duty.

Other:

- There will be a one-day delay in trash, yard waste, and curbside recyclables collection for customers served by the Environmental Services Department beginning Friday, January 1, 2010, due to the New Year's Day holiday. As such, Friday's collection will occur on Saturday.
- Trash and recycling collection will return to its normal schedule Monday, January 4, 2010.
- The City's Miramar Landfill will be closed on New Year's Day. The Landfill will return to its normal operating schedule, from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., on Saturday, January 2, 2010.
- The City's "refuse/recyclables" container sales office on Miramar Place will be closed on Friday, January 1, 2010.
- The City's Miramar Household Hazardous Waste facility will be closed on Saturday, January 2, 2010. The facility will resume operations on Saturday, January 9, 2010.
- This holiday information for trash and recyclables collection is for the City of San Diego only. Residents in other cities should check with their waste hauler for holiday service schedules.
- Mission Bay Golf Course will close at dusk on Thursday, December 31, 2009. Golf courses and starter booths will be open normal hours on Friday, January 1, 2010 and holiday rates will apply.

- The Golf Administration office will be closed Monday, December 28, 2009 through Friday, January 1, 2010. Advance tee times and resident cards will be available Monday through Thursday during normal hours.
- Balboa Park will be open. All public buildings in Balboa Park will be closed. Some institutions will be open; please contact the individual institution of interest for operating hours.

Specific Closures within the City of San Diego:

- All Administrative Offices will be closed on Friday, January 1, 2010.
- The Testing, Employment Information Center and Background/Fingerprinting offices within the Personnel Department will be closed Friday, December 25, 2009 through Friday, January 1, 2010.
- Open Space and Maintenance Assessment District Offices will be closed on Friday, January 1, 2010.
- Tecolote Nature Center will be closed on Friday, January 1, 2010.
- Mission Trails Regional Park Visitor Center will be closed on Friday, January 1, 2010.
- All City recreation centers will be closed on Friday, January 1, 2010.
- All City pools will be closed on Friday, January 1, 2010.
- Robb Field Skate Park (Ocean Beach), Rancho Peñasquitos Skate Park, Carmel Valley Skate Park, Bill and Maxine Wilson Skate Park (702 South 30th St.), and the Charles L. Lewis III Memorial Skate Park (6610 Potomac St.) will be open on Friday, January 1, 2010.
- All libraries will be closed on Friday, January 1, 2010. Please visit the City's website at www.sandiegolibrary.org or a special schedule that has been set for the City libraries for December 24, 2009 through January 1, 2010.
- Parking meters, time restrictions on parking on streets and yellow zones within the City of San Diego will not be in force. Red and white zones are still enforced on holidays. Parking rules on Port property and in different cities may vary so please read signage provided.
