The City of San Diego *Proclamation*

KENSINGTON-NORMAL HEIGHTS BRANCH LIBRARY 60th Anniversary Celebration

April 12, 2014

WHEREAS, Kensington Park Land Company deeds the land for Kensington Park to San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, the original 1,000 square foot Spanish-style library was built in the park in 1937 by County Property Department and Works Progress Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Kensington Park and Library were annexed to the City of San Diego on October 23, 1953, and opened to the community on April 1, 1954; and

WHEREAS, in 1962 the Kensington-Normal Heights Library was remodeled to 2,734 square feet to support increased usage of a variety of services; and

WHEREAS, the Kensington-Normal Heights Library holds over 140,000 books and provides a wide variety of other services; and

WHEREAS, with the support of the Friends, the library has flourished, providing the means for equipment, books and many fun and engaging events for all ages for both Kensington and Normal Heights communities; and

WHEREAS, the Kensington-Normal Heights Library usage has continually increased through the years and our Friends group is in the planning stages of renovations to the inside of the building; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2014, the Kensington-Normal Heights Library will celebrate its 60th anniversary with a community-wide celebration;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT PROCLAIMED, that I, Mayor Kevin L. Faulconer, on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, proclaim April 12, 2014, to be "**KENSINGTON-NORMAL HEIGHTS BRANCH LIBRARY DAY**" in the City of San Diego.
