✓ **Academic Search Elite** - Multi-disciplinary database with full-text for nearly 2,050 scholarly journals, from 1985-present.

Alt HealthWatch – 170+ alternative medicine and health magazines.

American History Online - Authoritative reference to the most important individuals, events, and topics in United States history.

Ancestry Library - Resources for genealogical and historical research, with more than 1.5 billion names in over 4,000 databases. (SDPL Locations only)

✓ **AP Photo Archive** - Newspaper photos, graphics, audio files; most are from 1995-present, some historical.

ATLA Religion Database - Over 1,500 theology and religion journals. (Central Library only)

Bibliographic Index Plus - Full-text bibliographies from some 1,700 journals across a broad range of disciplines. (Central Library only)

Biography and Genealogy Master Index - Indexes biographical information on multiple persons from print source, also acts as an index to other indexes.

✓ **Biography Resource Center** - Over 300,000 full and over 900,000 capsule biographies, plus related articles.

✓ **Books in Print (Patrons)** - Publication information on 5.6 million book, audio book, and video titles.

Books in Print (Professional) - Professional bibliographic database with 5.6 million book, audio book, and video titles, including reviews.



✓ **Business Source Premier** - Full-text for 8,500+ business journals, some from 1922-present.

✓ **Health & Wellness Resource Center** - Health and medical information for research from periodicals, reference books, and pamphlet sources.

Health Source: Consumer Edition - Consumer health information, covering medical sciences, food sciences and nutrition, child care, sports medicine and more.

✓ **History Study Center** - Access to a range of topical, well-organized online history collections.

Hoover's Company Capsules & Profiles - 17,000+ company descriptions, financials, key officers, and news.

Humanities Index - Full-text plus abstracts and bibliographic indexing of scholarly sources in the humanities. (Central Library only)

Kid's InfoBits - For K-5 students, information on current events, arts, science, health, people, history, and more.

Kids Search - Easy search interface, designed for elementary (K-6 grades) school students, for magazines and journals from databases.

Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts (LISTA) - From mid-1960s-present. Subjects covered include librarianship, classification, cataloging, bibliometrics, online information, and retrieval information.

Library Literature & Information Science Index - Indexes English and foreign language periodicals, selected state journals, conference proceedings, and more. (Central Library only)

✓ **Literature Resource Center** - Biographies, articles, criticism, overviews, and glossary on writers and literature.

✓ **Magazines and Journals List** - See journal titles available in print or online. Find out which journals are available for access or searching.

✓ **MAS Ultra: School Edition** - Primarily for high schools, this database provides full-text for 600+ popular general interest and current events publications. Books, biographies, primary source documents, and over 107,000 images.



✓ **MasterFILE Premier** - In-depth multidisciplinary database, with full-text for over 2,050 general reference publication with full-text information dating from 1975.

MedicLatina (English interface) - MedicLatina is a Spanish language collection of medical research and investigative journals.

Military & Government Collection - Current news pertaining to all branches of the military and government, full-text for nearly 400 journals.

Mitchell OnDemand Vehicle Database - Service, diagnostics and estimating for vehicles online, 1983-current Domestic and import models, diagrams, tech bulletins, and more. (Central Library only)

✓ **NetLibrary (eBooks)** - Collection of digital books (eBooks). Checkout or view online, some downloadable for use offline.

✓ **New York Times Archive** - Complete run of the *New York Times*, from Sep 18, 1851 to Dec 31, 2003.

✓ **Newspapers - National and Regional** - National and regional newspapers -- including *SD Union-Tribune*, *New York Times*, and *Wall Street Journal*.

✓ **Novelist** - Guide to suggested reading for all ages, with reviews and other features.

✓ **Novelist K-8** - Guide to suggested reading for children in grades K-8, with reviews and other features. Includes features for teachers.

Play Index - Covers 30,000+ plays, 1949-present. Includes one-act and radio/tv plays. (Central Library only)

✓ **Primary Search** - Full-text for more than 60 popular magazines for elementary school research, from 1990-present.

RAND California - Detailed social and educational statistics for California.

RDS Business Suite - 1,000+ business publications, covers manufacturing and service industries, including companies, products,

brands. (Central Library only)

Reader's Guide to Periodical Literature - Current events coverage, curriculum support, and quality periodical research for all. (Central Library only)

✓ **ReferenceUSA** - U.S. business, residential, and health care telephone directories. White pages and yellow pages type listings.

Regional Business News - Full-text coverage for over 75 business journals, newspapers, and news wires from all metropolitan and rural areas within the United States.

Salud para todos (English interface) - Provides full-text Spanish-language information for a wide variety of medical and health-related topics. Searchable in English, majority content in Spanish only.

Sams Photofacts - 1946 to present; small consumer electronics, diagrams, instructions, and data for the repair technician. Schematics for radios, TVs, stereos, and VCRs. (Central Library only)

Science Fulltext Select - A broad range of important science literature in one 100% full-text database. (Central Library only)

✓ **Science Online** - For students and teachers. Printable diagrams, definitions, biographies, experiments, timelines, and essays.

Searchasaurus - Provides a child-friendly dinosaur-based search interface to [Primary Search](#). Great for elementary and middle school students, and homework.

Serials Directory - Access to bibliographic information as well as current pricing structures for popular magazines, covering U.S. and international titles and publishers.

✓ **Standard & Poor's** - Financial reporting on investment devices, companies, industries, and the economy.

✓ **Student Research Center** - Easy search interface, designed for secondary school students, for magazines and journals from databases.

Tax Forms - Federal, California, and other states tax forms.

Ulrichsweb - Detailed information on serials and journals published around the world. (Central Library only)

United Nations Common Database (UNCDB) - UN country information and time series data. (SDPL Locations only)
