Jung Trio to Perform at Central Library *Program Will Include Piano Trios by Haydn, Piazzola, and Brahms*

SAN DIEGO – The sixth and final concert of the 2009 Winter/Spring Concert Series of the City of San Diego Public Library will take place on Sunday, May 10, with the Jung Trio, featuring Jennie Jung, piano; Ellen Jung, violin; and Julie Jung, cello. This FREE Mother’s Day program will be held at 2:30 p.m. in the third floor auditorium of the Central Library, 820 E St., in downtown San Diego.

The program will include the following:

Joseph Haydn, Piano Trio in C major, Hob. XV:27

Astor Piazzola, *Invierno Porteno* (Winter) from *Las Cuatro Estaciones Portenas* (The Four Seasons of Buenos Aires), arranged by Jose Bragato

Johannes Brahms, Piano Trio in B major, Opus 8

Hailed for its soul-stirring, captivating performances of supreme artistry, the Jung Trio, “a spectacular group with wonderful musicality at their fingertips,” (Ezra Laderman, composer and Dean Emeritus of Yale University) has established its status as one of the most notable rising young ensembles of today. The members of the group—sisters Jennie, Ellen, and Julie Jung—were born and raised in Toronto; each contributes her own singular warmth and impassioned sensibility to the collaborative force.

The trio has appeared in concerts all across North America as well as around the world. In April 2007, they swept the auditions of the Consortium of Southern California Chamber Music Presenters held in Beverly Hills. As a result, the trio was presented on Los Angeles County Museum of Art’s

"Sundays Live," the Beverly Hills "Music in the Mansion," and the Trinity Lutheran, Manhattan Beach "Previews" concert series last season, and have return engagements this season. The Jung Trio was also selected to make its debut at the 10th International Laureates Festival, presented each summer in Los Angeles by Young Artists International.

Highlights from past seasons include a concert tour of South Korea, debut performance in Disney Hall, performances of the Beethoven Triple Concerto with the Korean-Canadian Symphony Orchestra in Toronto, Canada, as well as engagements in Los Angeles, New York, San Francisco, Maryland and Toronto.

The Jung Trio recently recorded the music of Dvorak and Shostakovich for Groove Note Records.

The concert is free and open to the public. Free parking is available at the Five Star Parking lot adjacent to the Library on Broadway and 8th. In addition, parking meters are not enforced on Sundays, and other pay parking lots are available in the vicinity of the library.
