### **THE SAN DIEGO PUBLIC LIBRARY HOSTS A PRESENTATION ON *RADICAL ISLAM***

*Radical Islam Discussed from a Post-September 11 Perspective*

**SAN DIEGO** – The San Diego Public Library will host a presentation on *Radical Islam: Its Components and Root Causes* on Saturday, August 15 at 2:00 p.m. in the 3rd floor auditorium of the Central Library, located at 820 E Street in downtown San Diego. This FREE event is open to the public.

Most Americans were shocked and saddened in the wake of September 11, 2001. As the years have passed, a clash of civilizations appears to be increasingly manifest as radical Islam – a small, vocal faction not to be confused with the Islam practiced by more than one billion people world-wide – and the West seem at times to be talking past each other and destined for a collision course. Michael Hayutin, the local director of Act! For America will give a slide presentation/lecture on radical Islam and describe the threat some Americans feel that it represents.
