**HIV/AIDS INFORMATION LITERACY COMPUTER WORKSHOPS HOSTED
AT THE SAN DIEGO PUBLIC LIBRARY**

Workshops Focus on Teaching Skills to Find Answers to Medical Questions

SAN DIEGO –The San Diego Public Library will host a series of instructional workshops to teach patrons the skills they need to access information about HIV/AIDS online. The hour-long classes are free of charge and will be held in computer labs at several City libraries.

Patrons will learn how to use widely available and authoritative online resources to answer their questions about HIV/AIDS. Instructors will show how to navigate these websites to find information about clinical trials, current treatment and guidelines, alternative therapies, FDA-approved and investigational drugs, the latest on HIV vaccines and other news. Patrons will also learn where to find support organizations, a glossary of HIV/AIDS-related terms and statistics.

The workshops are presented by medical library faculty from the Pacific College of Oriental Medicine and will include computer exercises and handouts.
