Camarada Trio Performs Music of the Imagination

Program Features Works by Schumann, Reinecke, Buss, and Martinů

SAN DIEGO – The sixth and final concert in the City of San Diego Public Library fall concert series will be held on Saturday, November 14, 2009 at 2:30 p.m. The program, titled “Fairy Tales: Music of the Imagination,” will feature the Camarada Trio, which includes Travis Maril, viola; Dana Burnett, piano; and Beth Ross-Buckley, flute. The FREE performance will be held in the third floor auditorium of the Central Library, located at 820 E Street in downtown San Diego.

The program will include the following works:

- Carl Reinecke: “Undine” Sonata, Op. 167
- Robert Schumann: Märchenbilder (Fairy Tales), Op. 113
- Bohuslav Martinů: Trio
- Howard J. Buss: The Trail to Abrams Falls (2001)

Camarada, the chamber music ensemble, is dedicated to presenting invigorating performances of musical masterworks. It was created in 1994 by Beth Ross-Buckley, flute, Ann Chase, soprano and Mary Barranger, piano. After 15 years of successful music-making, a new vision for Camarada will emphasize its original camaraderie and genuine passion of making music together. Travis Maril and Dana Burnett join founding member Beth Ross-Buckley in this new venture. All three have significant chamber music experience and bring to Camarada a renewed zest for intimate chamber music, collaborating with a variety of artists, commissioning music by American composers and recording projects.

The concert is free and open to the public. Pay parking lots and metered parking are available in the vicinity of the library.
