**Library goes “Mobile,” Adds E-Mail, Facebook, and Twitter “Share” Links**  
*New Features Improve Access to Downloadable eAudiobooks, eVideos from OverDrive*

**SAN DIEGO** – The San Diego Public Library (SDPL) Digital Media Library at <http://sdpl.lib.overdrive.com/> is now available for easy browsing, searching, and real-time check-out of eAudiobooks or eVideos on-the-go -- from a smartphone, BlackBerry®, or other Web-enabled device. Users have instant access on the trolley or in line at the grocery store to a growing collection that currently includes 150 videos and over 1,900 audiobooks. Mobile devices will recognize the mobile site via the website address. Those users with devices running Windows Mobile now can also wirelessly download eAudiobooks and eVideos to those mobile devices using [OverDrive® Media Console for Windows Mobile](#). Full download support for other mobile operating systems (iPhone, BlackBerry®, etc.) is expected at a future date.

Sharing Features Added

To provide users of our [SDLP Digital Media Library](#) a more interactive experience, OverDrive has added the functionality to send e-mails about a title to friends and family from the site, and to post details about a downloadable title to the social networking sites Facebook and Twitter.
