GRANT FROM SONY EXPANDS LIBRARY'S eBook COLLECTION

SAN DIEGO – Through a generous \$10,000 grant from Sony Electronics, Inc., the San Diego Public Library has recently added new popular and best selling eBook titles to its eCollection, including the 2010 *One Book, One San Diego* selection *Outcasts United*. Using a San Diego Public Library card, library patrons now can download to their home computers almost 1,000 digital book titles, with more titles being added soon. These new eBooks, which can be checked out for 21 days, join eAudiobooks, eVideos and Digital Archives also available for download. In addition to the grant, Sony is providing eReaders for check out at five San Diego Public Libraries. “This exciting partnership places the San Diego Public Library at the forefront in making e-reader content and technologies available to library users,” said Library Director Deborah Barrow. “While many library systems offer e-books for loan, the Readers for Check-out Program positions San Diego as one of the first public library systems in the nation to make e-reader devices available for check-out.” To check out an eReader, place a hold, or find out more, call one of these participating locations: the Central Library and the City Heights/Weingart, Mission Valley, North University Community and Rancho Bernardo branch libraries.
