Old Town Theatre Hosting Free Neighborhood Party to Support Library

SAN DIEGO – The Cygnnet Theatre in Old Town has announced that its first Tuesday on Twiggs Street event will benefit the Mission Hills Branch of the San Diego Public Library. This party begins at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 19, 2010, and admission is free (just bring a gift for the library). The Cygnnet Theatre is located at 4040 Twiggs Street.

To meet its neighbors and give back to the community, each quarter the Cygnnet Theatre will focus on a specific neighborhood by throwing a free event to support the library serving that area. Local residents, as well as the general public, are invited to bring donations and “wish list” items for the designated library to a neighborhood party at the Cygnnet Theatre. Each event will include free wine and other beverages, appetizers, behind-the-scenes tours, prize drawings, and opportunities to meet artists who produce and perform in the plays.

The Mission Hills Branch Library’s wish list includes new books (especially popular current novels), DVDs, CDs, Lakeshore Learning gift certificates, and cash donations toward furniture for the children’s area of the library.

The Mission Hills Branch Library is located at 925 West Washington Street, San Diego 92103. The Library's hours of operation are Tuesday and Wednesday 12:30 to 8:00 p.m., Thursday and Friday 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Saturday 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., and closed Sunday and Monday.

Cygnnet has received over 50 awards and grown to one of the most highly regarded theatre companies in the San Diego area. In December 2007, Cygnnet was awarded a 10-year lease by State of California Department of Parks and Recreation Concessions and Reservations Division of the Old Town Theatre. Located in Old Town San Diego State Historic Park, the 248-seat venue was renovated during the summer and fall of 2008.
