SAN DIEGO – The San Diego Public Library’s City Heights/Weingart Branch and the San Diego Stanford University Alumni Chapter are proud to announce their participation in Stanford University’s *Creating Change Beyond the Farm* community service program. This will be Stanford University’s first global day of service with the hope of making it bigger every year. This event brings Stanford alumni in San Diego together on one day to provide hands-on service to the City Heights community. Services available during the day will be alumni-led and reflect the diversity of alumni interest and passions. The event will take place on Saturday, May 14, 2011 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The program is inspired by the actions of Stanford alumni and their long tradition of service to others. Stanford University has over 200,000 alumni and the *Beyond the Farm* program seeks to extend Stanford’s spirit of service to communities around the world through the volunteer efforts of alumni, family and friends.

During the day of the event, the library will have over 50 Stanford volunteers and a variety of stations that patrons can go to for computer instruction, nutritional and legal assistance. There will be plenty of activities for children.
