Spend Friday Afternoons in the Month of November with Hollywood's Cranky Genius

SAN DIEGO – The San Diego Public Library will screen four cinema masterpieces by iconic and enigmatic filmmaker Stanley Kubrick every Friday in November at 2:30 p.m. in the third floor auditorium of the Central Library, located at 820 E Street in downtown San Diego. **Friday Talking Pictures** is the library's weekly movie showcase, a world-spanning celebration of contemporary and classic cinema. Audience discussions will oftentimes follow the screenings. This event is FREE and open to the public.

November 4th – *Lolita* – A middle-aged college professor becomes infatuated with a 14-year-old teen.

November 11th – *A Clockwork Orange* – A jailed, juvenile delinquent volunteers for an experimental therapy developed by the government in an effort to solve society's crime problem.

November 18th – *Paths of Glory* – When soldiers in WWI refuse to continue with an impossible attack, their superiors decide to make an example of them.

November 25th – *The Shining* – A family heads to an isolated hotel for the winter where an evil, spiritual presence haunts the father's violent ghosts.
